Tip #3: Shapes, Numbers, Colors

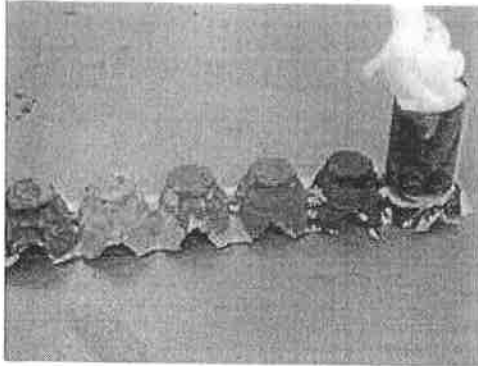
Below are some activities and experiments you and your child can do at home.

### Egg Carton Train

**Materials:** Egg carton, toilet paper, cotton balls, scissors, and glue.

**What to do?** : Cut out half of an egg carton row and glue an empty toilet paper roll on top of the egg carton. Using cotton balls glue a few coming out of the toilet paper roll. Color or paint over it. Be creative and add your own ideas if you'll like!

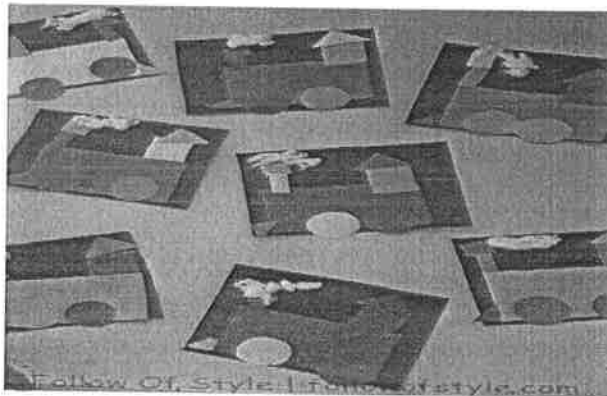


### **Make Your Own Transportation**

**Materials:** Color Paper, scissors, and glue

**What to do:** Cut paper into different shapes and glue onto a blank sheet creating your own transportation. It can be a car, boat, plane or train like the example below.

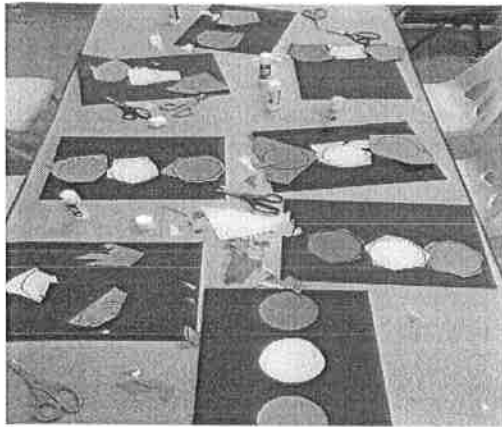
**\*If you don't have color paper, a blank white paper is ok\* Color shapes in after with crayon.**

**Materials:** Scissors, glue, and paper

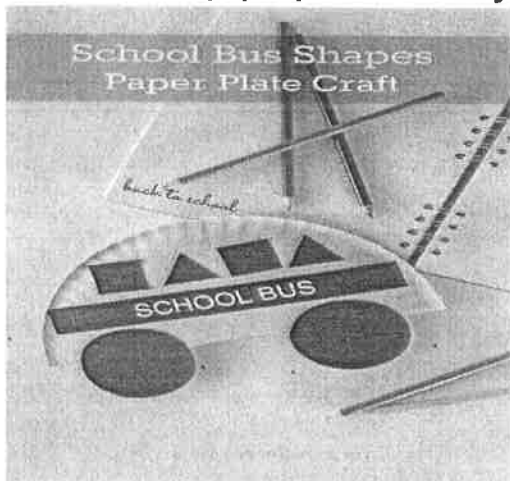
**What to do:** Cut out three circles and glue onto a blank sheet to create a traffic light. Color the three circles green for go, yellow for slow and red for stop.

**Materials:** Paper plate, scissors, glue and paper

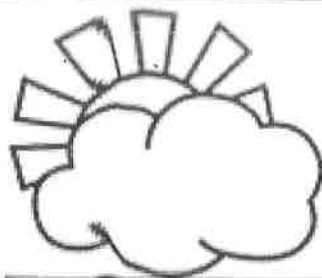
**What to do:** Cut the paper plate in half and color it. Cut out different shapes and glue them onto the paper plate to make your own school bus.



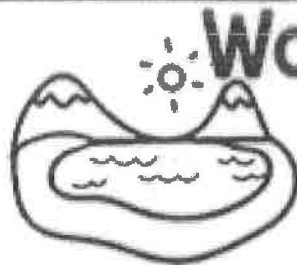
