Tip #3: Shapes, Numbers, Colors


Below are some activities and experiments you and your child can do at home.

Arts & Crafts:

Egg Carton Flower

Materials: Egg carton, scissors, coloring material, and glue or tape

What to do: Cut off the last two rolls of the egg carton. Leaving you with four egg holders left. Let your child paint or color the egg carton bright spring colors. With the finishing touches add a straw to the back of the egg carton.



My Flower

Materials: Coloring materials and paper


What to do: Before you start this activity create an image of a sunflower using paint (you want to have an image of what your child is going to make beforehand). Go over the parts of a plant (stem, leaf, and flower). Have your child create each part using their fingers (yes, let's get in the mess!)



Easter Toilet Paper Roll Bunny


Materials: Toilet Paper Roll, Pipe Cleanser, construction paper, glue

What to do: Cut bunny ears with construction paper. Have your child color the toilet paper roll and the ears. With glue add the pipe cleaners onto the paper roll. Don't forget to make your bunny silly face.



Easter Eggs Kool Aid

Materials: Large Plastic Cups, Different Color Kool-aid Dye, Spoons & Water **What to do:** Fill your bowls with about 3/4 a cup of water, pour in a packet of Kool-Aid and drop your eggs into the bowl. Leave them there for about 2-5 minutes, and then pull them out to dry.



Sponge Paint Easter Egg

Materials: Spongs, Different Color Paint, White Construction Paper, Tape

What to do: Cut white construction paper into an oval. Put tape of different sizes on the cut out egg shape. With the different colors and sponges, have your child paint the egg using the sponges. When all dry take the tape off to see the design




Science Activities

Sprouting Seeds

Materials: Jar or ziplock bag, power paper, and seed


What to do: STEP 1: Fill the jar with paper towels. Kids can fold them and push them down into the jar. This is also great work for little hands. STEP 2: Gently put your seed into the jar with the wet paper towels. DO NOT FLOOD IT! STEP 3: Carefully push seeds down into the

paper towels around the edge of the jar so they can still be seen. Make sure they are firmly held in place.




Gross Motor Activities
